And snow-white turtle doves.

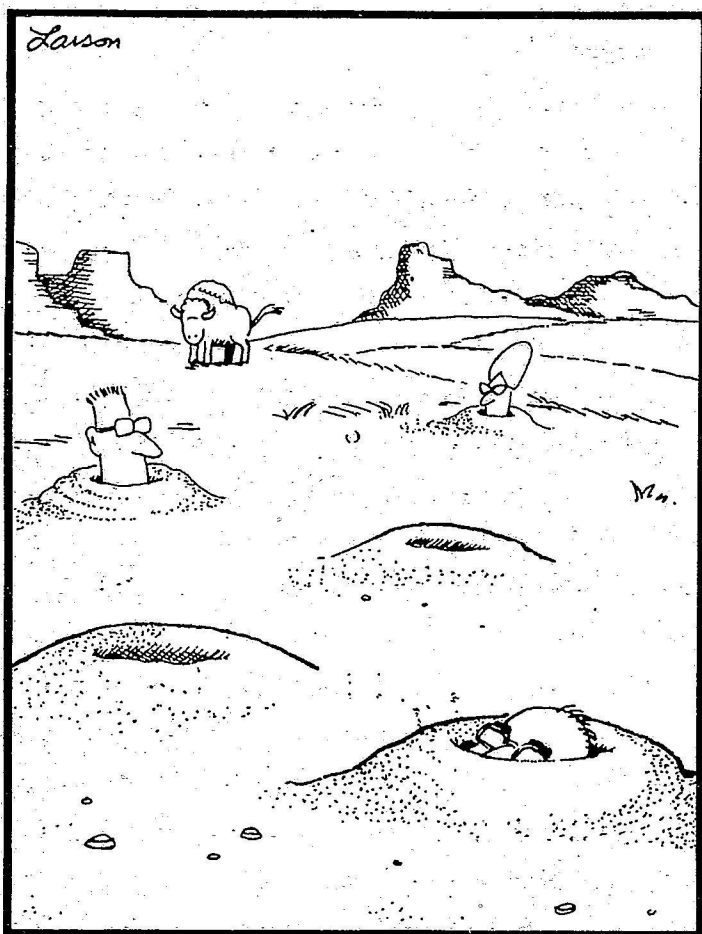
I'd like to teach the world to sing
