Chandogya Upanishad:

A young man, Shevetaketu, has been away studying and memorizing priestly lore—chants and rituals—with a specialist for many years. The young man's father questions him about what he has learned and his son proudly recites the many formulas he knows. The father then asks him what he knows about Brahman, the Supreme Spirit; but the young man knows nothing. Trying to assist the son's understanding the father asks his son to fill a glass with water, put salt in it, and leave it overnight. The next day he asks his son to find the salt:

"Bring me the salt you put into the water last night."

Shevetaketu looked into the water, but could not find it, for it had dissolved.

His father then said: "taste the water from the side. How is it?"

"It is salt"

"Taste it from the middle. How is it?"

"It is salt."

Taste it from that side. How is it?"

"It is salt."

"Look for the salt again and come again to me."

The son did so, saying: "I cannot see the salt. I only see water."

The father then said: "In the same way, O my son, you cannot see the Spirit. But in truth he is here.

"An invisible and subtle essence is the Spirit of the whole universe. That is Reality. That is Truth. Thou art That."
