A Little About the Free Congregation,

This congregation began as the Freie Gemeinde (The Free Congregation) in 1852. Its founders were seeking freedom to practice their beliefs, exprèss their thoughts, and search for the truth without interference from government and church. Park Hall, still known locally as Freethinkers Hall, was constructed in 1884, designed by Sauk City born architect Alfred Clas.

Communities of Gratified

In 1955, our congregation affiliated with the American Unitarian Association, a movement for liberal religious thought and practice. In 1961 the Unitarian Association and the Universalist Denomination merged, and we took on the name that we bear today: The Free Congregation of Sauk County—a Unitarian Universalist Fellowship.

A Little About Prairie Unitarian Universalist Society,

Prairie is a freethinking religious community in Madison Wisconsin that aspires to be both open-hearted and open-minded.

Prairie Unitarian Universalist Society was established in 1967 as an offshoot of the First Unitarian Society of Madison (FUS) in an effort to relieve overcrowding in FUS's religious education program.

In 1980 Prairie purchased its own building now called The Meeting House at 2010 Whenona Drive which underwent extensive remodeling in 1988 and 2019. In 2013 Prairie purchased the house next door now called The Annex for small group meeting and office space. A 2-volume history of the congregation is available for \$25 with copies available after today's service.


